The project

Eurojoiner project, developed between 2015 and 2017 under the Erasmus + program, aims to define a European qualification for the Carpenter profile in order to facilitate and promote the mobility of these workers in the European context. To define this profile are considered the competencies and activities in each of the countries represented in the partnership (AIDIMME - Spain, Amledo & Co AB - Sweden, CIPFP - Catarroja - Spain, CFPIMM - Portugal, HMC - Netherlands Organize Sanayi Bolgesi Mesleki ve Teknik Egitim Merkezi - Turkey and Woodwize - Belgium).

The objectives

- 1. Elaborate the European profile of carpenter with the definition of the activities, knowledge and skills.
- 2. Elaborate training material in e-learning format that gathers the competences defined.
- 3. Design and develop a self-assessment system that determines whether a worker or student has the skills necessary for this professional profile.

The results

- 1. European Qualification European *Eurojoiner*.
- 2. Training course in e-learning format, integrating the following steps: definition of learning objectives, contents development, translation into English, insertion in the Moodle platform and pilot test.
